ABOUT MINT

The project supports and facilitates the integration process of migrant children, enhances their social relations and empowers them as well as local youth in the **Czech Republic, Poland, Romania and Slovenia** through an innovative peer-to-peer mentoring programme, language courses and cultural introduction, and child-led awareness raising and advocacy actions. The project specifically supports the integration of newly arrived children, including unaccompanied and separated children, paying particular attention to the gender-specific barriers to integration of girls and boys.

OBJECTIVE OF THE EVENT

One of the aims of the event is to present the results of the MINT project as well as the **Mentoring Methodology Framework** developed in the project. The event will offer a good opportunity for participants to learn more about the mentoring concept and discuss its possible use in their country context.
